### Contractor V License Renewal Reminder

------

UUCF would like to remind you that your Contractor V license from the State Fire Marshal's office is up for renewal on June 30, 2012. Current law requires Contractor V licenseholders to obtain 14 hours of continuing education with at least one hour in fire protection discipline.

Remember, there is reciprocity between the State Fare Marshal's office and Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB). Therefore, continuing education hours secured for your Contractor V license will apply to your underground utility and excavation contractor's license with the CILB and vise versa.

Be sure to obtain your continuing education early. Don't wait until the last minute.

#### Certified Contractor License Renewal Reminder

Just a reminder that the Certified Contractor licenses from the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) are up for renewal on August 31, 2012. Current law requires licenseholders to obtain 14 hours of continuing education with at least one hour in workplace safety, one hour in workers' compensation, one hour in business practices, one hour in the advance building code module, one hour in laws and rules (Chapter 489) and one hour in wind mitigation (this requirement only affects general, residential, building, roofing and glass and glazing contractors).

Don't forget to notify the DBPR office of any address change. Section 489.124(2) gives sole responsibility to the licensee for notifying DBPR in writing of the licensee's current mailing address and phone number.

Failure to notify the department of a change of address shall constitute a violation of this section. In addition, if your address changes and you do not notify the department, you may not receive important mailings from the department such as your renewal notice.

OSHA Kicks Off Summer Campaign to Prevent Heat–Related Illnesses and Fatalities Among Outdoor Workers

The U.S. Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration has kicked off a national outreach initiative to educate workers and their employers about the hazards of working outdoors in hot weather. The outreach effort builds on last year's successful summer campaign to raise awareness about the dangers of too much sun and heat.

"For outdoor workers, 'water, rest and shade' are three words that can make the difference between life and death," Secretary of Labor Hilda L. Solis said. "If employers take reasonable precautions, and look out for their workers, we can beat the heat."

Every year, thousands of workers across the country suffer from serious heat-related illnesses. If not quickly addressed, heat exhaustion can become heat stroke, which has killed – on average – more than 30 workers annually since 2003. Labor-intensive activities in hot weather can raise body temperatures beyond the level that normally can be cooled by sweating. Heat illness initially may manifest as heat rash or heat cramps, but quickly can become heat exhaustion and then heat stroke if simple prevention steps are not followed. "It is essential for workers and employers to take proactive steps to stay safe in extreme heat, and become aware of symptoms of heat exhaustion before they get worse," said Dr. David Michaels, assistant secretary of labor for occupational safety and health. "Agriculture workers; building, road and other construction workers; utility workers; baggage handlers; roofers; landscapers; and others who work outside are all at risk. Drinking plenty of water and taking frequent breaks in cool, shaded areas are incredibly important in the hot summer months."

### NLRB Poster Requirement Update



In last month's issue of the Ditchmen, we reported that the new poster that was going to be required by the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) was postponed until April 30, 2012. The NLRB is an agency of the federal government that oversees employees' rights to form unions in the workplace. This poster advises employees of their right to unionize.

D.C. has temporarily stopped the NLRB from requiring this new poster, so the new poster requirement will not take effect until this court decision is resolved. Until we receive further notice, you do not have to post this poster.

In preparation for the summer season, OSHA has developed heat illness educational materials in English and Spanish, as well as a curriculum to be used for workplace training. Additionally, a Web page provides information and resources on heat illness – including how to prevent it and what to do in case of an emergency – for workers and employers. The page is available at *http://www.osha.gov/SLTC/ heatillness/index.html*.

OSHA also has released a free application for mobile devices that enables workers and supervisors to monitor the heat index at their work sites. The app displays a risk level for workers based on the heat index, as well as reminders about protective measures that should be taken at that risk level. Available for Android–based platforms and the iPhone, the app can be downloaded in both English and

In developing last year's inaugural national campaign, federal OSHA worked closely with the California Occupational Safety and Health Administration and adapted materials from that state's successful campaign. Additionally, OSHA is partnering with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration for the second year to incorporate worker safety precautions when heat alerts are issued across the nation. NOAA also will include pertinent worker safety information on its heat watch Web page at http:// www.noaawatch.gov/themes/ heat.php.

### Public Bid Openings Update

On May 4, 2012, Governor Scott signed into law HB 897, *Chapter Law 2012–211*. For the most part, the bill, an act relating to construction contracting, clarifies the responsibility of all parties as it relates to construction liens and bonds.

For UUCF members, there is one very important provision unrelated to construction liens and bonds. Section 3 requires governmental entities to announce at the public meeting the name of each bidder and the price submitted and to make the name and price information available upon request. Under s. 119.071(1)(b), F.S., sealed bids are exempt from disclosure requirements under public records laws until "the agency provides notice of an intended decision or until 30 days after opening the bids . . ., whichever is earlier." As a result of the public records exemption, the components of a sealed bid, other than a bidder's name and price submitted, are likely to remain exempt from disclosure until the agency provides notice of an intended decision or for 30 days after the meeting at which the bids are opened, whichever is earlier.

This provision took effect on May 4, 2012.
