

Contractor V License Renewal Reminder

UUCF would like to remind you that your Contractor V license from the State Fire Marshal's office is up for renewal on June 30, 2014. Current law requires Contractor V licenseholders to obtain 14 hours of continuing education with at least one hour in fire protection discipline.

Remember, there is reciprocity between the State Fire Marshal's office and Construction Industry Licensing Board (CILB). Therefore, continuing education hours secured for your Contractor V license will apply to your underground utility and excavation contractor's license with the CILB and vise versa.

Be sure to obtain your continuing education early. Don't wait until the last minute.

Florida Insurance Commissioner Announces Decision on NCCI Workers' Compensation Rate Filing

Foliational Insurance Commissioner Kevin McCarty issued an *Order* notifying the National Council on Compensation Insurance (NCCI) that its 1% proposed annual rate filing increase in Florida's workers' compensation insurance rates has been disapproved. After a careful review and analysis by the Office of Insurance Regulation (Office), the filing reflected an increase in production expenses that were not supported by the information submitted by NCCI.

NCCI can re–submit the rate filing to the Office and a 0.7% increase would be approved to become effective on January 1, 2014 for new and renewal business. This approval would represent a 56.0% cumulative reduction in Florida workers' compensation rates as a result of legislative reforms introduced in 2003 and keep Florida rates comparable to other states.

"Although a marginal rate increase is necessary for worker's compensation insurance in Florida, the underlying factors causing the spike in rate increases over the last four years still merit legislative attention," stated Florida Insurance Commissioner, Kevin M. McCarty. "Evidence from the hearing demonstrated that rates could be reduced by as much as 8.3% if the reimbursement for hospital inpatient, hospital outpatient and ambulatory surgical centers were statutorily limited to 120% of Medicare reimbursement."







Certified Contractor License Renewal Reminder

Just a reminder that the Certified Contractor licenses from the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) are up for renewal on August 31, 2014. Current law requires licenseholders to obtain 14 hours of continuing education with at least one hour in workplace safety, one hour in workers' compensation, one hour in business practices, one hour in the advance building code module, one hour in laws and rules (Chapter 489) and one hour in wind mitigation (this requirement only affects general, residential, building, roofing and glass and glazing contractors).

Don't forget to notify the DBPR office of any address change. Section 489.124(2) gives sole responsibility to the licensee for notifying DBPR in writing of the licensee's current mailing address and phone number.

Failure to notify the department of a change of address shall constitute a violation of this section. In addition, if your address changes and you do not notify the department, you may not receive important mailings from the department such as your renewal notice.


