

Office Issues Orders Terminating Certain Cat Fund Emergency Assessments

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – The Florida Office of Insurance Regulation (Office) today issued Orders to insurance companies terminating a 1.3% assessment on most property insurance policies that has been used to pay off past hurricane claims. The assessment will be eliminated on policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2015 - 18 months ahead of schedule, due to an early payoff of the bonds used to pay the claims.

The Florida Hurricane Catastrophe Fund (Cat Fund) emergency assessment applied to all premiums on property and casualty insurance policies in Florida, including surplus lines, but excluded those lines specifically exempted by law. The charge began at 1% in 2007 and was increased to 1.3% in 2011. The \$2.9 billion collected through May 31, 2014 was used to reimburse insurance companies for claims from the series of eight hurricanes that hit Florida in 2004 and 2005.

The Cat Fund currently has \$12.95 billion available, which is made up of a projected 2014 year-end fund balance of \$10.95 billion and \$2 billion in pre-event bonds, with additional borrowing ability to pay future claims - its highest level in recent years.

Both Orders, one to property and casualty insurers and the second, to the Florida Surplus Lines Service Office (FSLSO) and surplus lines agents give specific guidance as to the types of insurance affected and related information on reporting requirements. An Informational Memoranda was also issued, providing further guidance.

Pursuant to the Orders, all policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2015, will no longer be subject to the Cat Fund emergency assessment. The assessment will continue to apply to the direct written premium on all related transactions including, but not limited to, endorsements, policy cancellations, and audit premiums related to policies issued or renewed prior to January 1, 2015 at the applicable percentage below:

- Policies issued or renewed on or after January 1, 2015: emergency assessment is 0%
- Policies issued or renewed January 1, 2011 December 31, 2014: emergency assessment is 1.3%
- Policies issued or renewed January 1, 2007 December 31,
 2011: emergency assessment is 1%
- Policies issued or renewed prior to January 1, 2007: emergency assessment is 0%



Gubernatorial Candidate Crist Proposes Busy First Day

Former Gov. Charlie Crist vowed July 29, 2014, that if he is elected, he will issue five executive orders on his first day in office.

They will target discrimination against gay and transgender employees and force state-hired contractors to pay employees at least \$10.10 an hour.

Other executive orders would deal with public records, equal pay for women and discrimination. One would require state agencies, where legally possible, to use Florida-based businesses in contracts.

The proposals from Crist echo several steps taken at the federal level by President Barack Obama. They represent another

effort by the former Republican to boost his credentials with Democratic voters.

Republican legislative leadership issued a joint statement about the proposals.

"Charlie Crist says he is a 'man of the people' but his actions don't match his rhetoric. Crist is lifting a dangerous page from President Obama's playbook, saying he will do an endrun around the people's elected representatives and single-handedly mandate policies through executive order. When Not To Pay a Local Business Tax

A Local Business tax is a miscellaneous tax imposed by local governments in Florida. Payment of the Local Business Tax allows you the right to do business in that county or municipality and is paid annually with the fiscal year beginning October 1 through September 30. This is a tax, not a license or competency card.

Many contractors throughout the state may be unwittingly paying for a local business tax when they don't have to. The following will give you a history of the tax as well as exemptions from taxation for certain businesses.

Chapter 205, Florida Statute, provides that the governing body of a county may levy, by appropriate resolution or ordinance, a business tax for the privilege of engaging in or managing any business, profession or occupation within its jurisdiction. Most counties and municipalities in Florida elected to collect Local Business Taxes (formerly known as Occupational License) when the state turned it over to local governments in 1972. In 2006, the Florida legislature renamed the Local Occupational License Tax to Local Business Tax (Chapter Law 2006-152). The change was made because the legislature found the reference to an occupational license was confusing to consumers and was not the correct characterization of the tax. It further found that unscrupulous persons presented a local occupational license to consumers as proof of competency to perform various repairs and service. Consumers were being victimized by these representations. By changing the name of the tax issued by local governments, the legislature believed it would go a long way in eliminating some fraudulent misrepresentation of this tax.

In 1992, s. 205.065, F.S., was created which provided that the local jurisdictions could not charge businesses regulated under the Department of Business and Professional Regulation (DBPR) a local business tax simply because the business was performing work in that jurisdiction. Instead, the ability to charge a local business tax was to be conditioned on having a place

of business located within that jurisdiction. This means that an underground utility & excavation contractor, for instance, located in Orange County, could not be charged a business tax by Seminole County simply because the contractor performs work in that jurisdiction. In 1999, the Florida legislature further amended that section of law (Chapter Law 99-254) to provide that a contractor who has been subjected to an unlawful levy of a business tax may challenge the local government's actions. If the contractor prevails, they are entitled to recover his or her reasonable attorney's fees.

In conclusions, be sure you're not paying local governments a local business tax that they are not entitled to under Florida law. Don't be coerced by local governments that demand you pay before you play . . . know the law.

Below is a copy of s. 205.065, F.S., for your reference.

205.065 Exemption; nonresident persons regulated by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.—If any person engaging in or managing a business, profession, or occupation regulated by the Department of Business and Professional Regulation has paid a business tax for the current year to the county or municipality in the state where the person's permanent business location or branch office is maintained, no other local governing authority may levy a business tax, or any registration or regulatory fee equivalent to the business tax, on the person for performing work or services on a temporary or transitory basis in another municipality or county. Work or services performed in a place other than the county or municipality where the permanent business location or branch office is maintained may not be construed as creating a separate business location or branch office of that person for the purposes of this chapter. Any properly licensed contractor asserting an exemption under this section who is unlawfully required by the local governing authority to pay a business tax, or any registration or regulatory fee equivalent to a business tax, has standing to challenge the propriety of the local government's actions, and the prevailing party in such a challenge is entitled to recover a reasonable attorney's fee.


